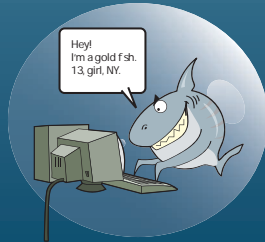


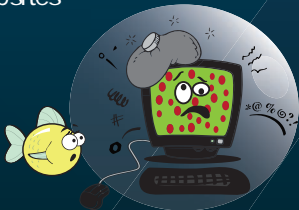
CHATTING

- Helps to develop communication skills, social skills and keep in touch with friends and family
- It also involves risks as people you meet online may not really be who they say they are
- ✓ DO learn how to save chat conversations so that you can report harassment
- ✗ DON'T turn on the webcam to a stranger or send photos of yourself to a stranger you meet online



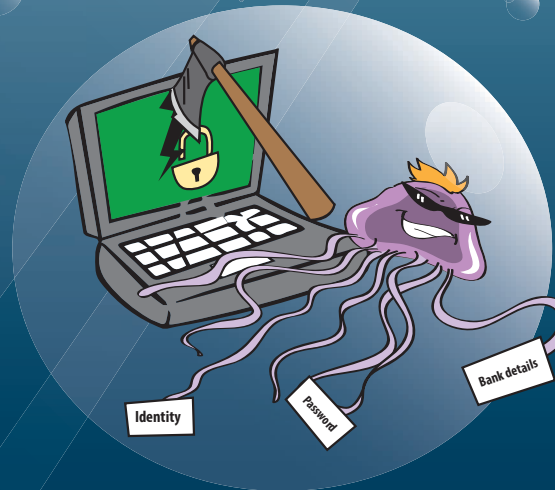
VIRUS

- A small program or code that can delete or destroy files
- It can be disguised as emails, links, audio/video files or attachments
- ✓ DO install and update anti-virus software and spam blocking programmes
- ✗ DON'T open spam emails or visit unsafe websites



FRAUD

- When people steal information, or cause harm by accessing information online, through deceptive and illegal means
- Eg: financial fraud, identity theft etc
- ✓ DO use strong passwords and remember to log off from your accounts
- ✗ DON'T share personal information, photo ID's, passwords and bank details



HACKING

- When someone gains unauthorized access to information in a system or computer
- Hackers get your passwords, emails and private data through your mail or social media accounts
- ✓ DO talk to a trusted adult, if anything makes you uncomfortable
- ✗ DON'T respond to inappropriate requests or make plans to meet up
